## DEPUTY COUNCIL YOUTH COMMISSIONER – RECOGNITION

### Accountable to:

Council Youth Commissioner (CYC)

### Shares Responsibility with:

As a member of the Council Service Team shares responsibility with the Deputy Council Commissioner-Recognition.

### Appointment:

Appointed annually by the Council Youth Commissioner, in consultation with the Council Commissioner and Executive Director, for a maximum of three (3) consecutive years.

### Time required:

20 - 25 hours per month in addition to any needed meetings.

### Role:

The DCYC - Recognition works in partnership with the DCC - Recognition in implementing and developing a recognition framework within the Council, as well as promoting meaningful youth involvement across the Council as a member of the Council Recognition Committee as well as the Council Leadership Team.

### Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Promote and gather youth recognition across the Council.
2. Work with Area Youth Commissioners and event organizing committees to identify youth deserving of recognition.
3. Work with the DCC - Recognition to set goals.
4. Be an active member of the Council Youth Network.
5. Attend and contribute at Council Recognition Committee meetings.
6. Attend Council Service Team meetings when needed or invited.
7. Prepare for Council recognition Committee meetings, and be prepared to chair the meetings in the DCC's absence.
8. Chair the Council Youth Recognition Committee.
9. Be a member or chair of the Youth Awards ceremony organizing committee.

### Ideal Qualifications:

The Deputy Council Youth Commissioner should be enthusiastic, committed to Scouting and possess a positive attitude. The Deputy Council Youth Commissioner should have the time available to excel in this role.
